### **Porto Alegre Airport delivers a new parking garage**

Fraport Brasil – Porto Alegre delivers today (June 1st) to the manager Estapar a new parking garage, located near Terminal 1, with five levels and 1,050 parking spots. With the new facilities, the airport will now have 2,805 spots, including the existing parking garage, the new one, and other parking areas. After the completion of the ongoing works and renovations, there will be a total of 4,300 parking spots.

Additionally, a new escalator will soon be added to the current check-in area, improving the flow of passengers from the 2nd to the 3rd level where the departure area is located.

Still in June, renovation works in the current domestic departure lounge will begin. The old check-in area, located on the 2nd level of Terminal 1, will be finished by the end of the quarter, serving international flights only. Therefore, the new check-in area, which was opened in April this year, will be exclusively dedicated to domestic flights, ensuring more comfort and agility for all airport users. A second state-of-the-art baggage carousel will be available to passengers arriving on international flights.

By the end of September, Azul Airlines is expected to start operating in Terminal 1. Thus, all operations will be located in one single Terminal, and Terminal 2 will only house the Control Tower and Fraport Brasil offices.

With investments amounting to BRL 1.8 billion, 60% of which were funded by the BNDES, the terminal's expansion is expected to be completed by October 2019, and the runway extension by 2021.

Sixty-three percent of the works have already been completed.

### **2019 Deliveries**

Porto Alegre Airport domestic check-in was relocated to a new, modern and well-lit area in the expanded section of the 2nd level of Terminal 1. The domestic departure was expanded and moved to the 3rd floor. The domestic arrivals area is now located in the expanded section, and baggage claim now sports world-class carousels. International passengers will use a new carousel too.

Also in 2019, the airport delivered a new domestic departure area (located in a pier), which has six new gates (119 to 124) and three new bridges. Gates 1 to 8 have been renumbered to 103, 104, 105, 106, 106R, 107, 108 and 109, respectively.
